

Year 1 - List of Pull Pages

Pull Pages are critical for different reasons:

- ✓ They provide tangible evidence that parents are engaging in activities with their child (Curriculum Standard #2 and #3)
- ✓ They provide a portfolio that can be shared with the kindergarten teacher when the child enters school
- ✓ They can be used to create a brag book to be presented to parents when their child's time in HIPYPY is completed
- ✓ They provide coordinators with a way to easily track each child's progress over time to determine what additional aids and/or interventions are needed (i.e., enrichment activities, developmental assessment).

The tables below (1-10 and 11-20) list the suggested pages to pull (collect) each week, along with the primary skill development reflected in the specified page. Coordinators are urged to inform staff of which page to pull at the staff meeting held just prior to the week when the page will be collected.

Special note: Because the activities in Year 1 use more manipulatives to promote active learning, there are not as many paper activity sheets to use as Pull Pages. Based on recommendations from some of the pilot sites, we suggest home visitors document some activities by taking photos with a cell phone or tablet. This concept is a new and exciting use of technology that will allow sites to document activities using manipulatives rather than only pencil and paper activities. During the pilot process, we also found that taking photos increases the parent's/family's gratification and feelings of success.

For week 2, taking a photo is the suggested form of documentation for the Pull Page. Therefore, each site is urged to explore how to make this happen. If the site is unable to take, print out and include this picture in the child's folder, the site will not be penalized.

Sites may/should hand out the Special Activity Sheets (included) to parents to use as the designated Pull Pages for Week 2 (alternate) and Week 4 (required). Please download the sheet and make a copy for each parent.
